WHEREAS it is considered necessary and expedient to have the declaration of the trust and terms and conditions thereof formally in writing, it is so recorded as under:

NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITNESSETH:

1. DECLARATION

The settlor hereby declares that he has entrusted an amount of Rs. 11,000 (Rupees Eleven Thousand only) in cash which is received and acknowledged by the trustees so as to form the corpus of **RADIANCE EDUCATIONAL TRUST, HISAR** formed with the objects and terms, to which the trust shall be subject, set out hereinafter.

2. NAME:

The Trust shall be known as **RADIANCE EDUCATIONAL TRUST, HISAR**

3. OFFICE OF THE TRUST

The Office of the Trust shall be at House No.112, Sector 15, Hisar, PIN - 125001, Haryana or such other place as may be decided from time to time

4. OBJECTS

The sole object of the trust is to promote education without profit motive by any or all the following modes:

- (i) to organise, to start, to run or assist any school, college other educational institution/s or to help any educational institution for the benefit of the general public in all fields, whether engineering, technical, medical, management or any other field of study, necessary and useful for the youth of this country.
- (ii) To organise, start, run or assist any programme either by itself or by assisting or co-ordinating with other educational or other institutions for coaching, guidance and counselling or vocational training.
- (iii) To run workshops, programmes, seminars etc. for the educated unemployed and the rural youth with or without co-ordination with other organisations.

- (iv) To conduct training in computer and other skills in educational institutions or independently to provide such education,
- (v) To give donations to educational institutions which are run on non-profit basis subject to such conditions consistent with the objects of the Trust.
- (vi) To constitute scholarships to poor and deserving students to enable them to continue their studies and to give concession for fees and other charges including hostel fees or reimbursement of costs of books, instruments and other educational aids for their educational pursuits.
- (vii) To help establishment of students hostel or to give other assistance for poor and deserving students to find inexpensive living accommodation to enable them to prosecute their studies.
- (viii) To constitute prizes for outstanding achievements of students in educational institutions either in the examinations, sports, general knowledge or such other proficiencies.
- (ix) To give loans at nil or subsidised low rate of interest to students to enable them to prosecute higher studies.
- (x) To undertake these and other incidental activities without profit motive and without discrimination on account of religion, caste, colour, creed or gender.
- (xi) The activities will be confined to Indian shores.
- (xii) If any of the above objects is found to be inconsistent with the objects of a public educational charitable institution under section 10(23 C) or 11 or any other section of the Income-tax Act, 1961 or any other law applicable to such trusts as now enacted or as may be enacted or amended at a future date, such object will stand, modified to accord with such law or amended law, so that this Trust will continue to have the character of a public education institution without profit motive with public character within meaning of section 10(23C) or 11 of the Income-tax Act, 1961 any other analogous provisions under the Income-tax Act or any other law.

5. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The trust is constituted with the following members as trustees collectively known as Board of Trustees:

All the first Seven trustees will be life trustees with settlor being Chairperson for his life.

It will be open to the Board to co-opt other trustees by consensus for life or such period as may be specified, so, however, the total number of the trustees at no time shall exceed nine. In the event of any trustee vacating his office for any reason whatsoever, the Board of Trustees may continue without such persons, so however the number of trustees will at no time get reduced below 3. If it happens to fall below 3, the vacancy will be filled up forthwith by other two by consensus.

6. TRUST FUND/TRUST BOARD/TRUSTEES

(a) Trust Fund/Property:

The trust fund will contain the initial corpus as settled herein and also any funds and contribution by well-wishers, other voluntary agencies and subscriptions from participants received for the furtherance of the objects upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may at their absolute discretion accept as long as they are not inconsistent with the objects of the trust.



All properties, whether movable or immovable, whether owned or entrusted to the Trust by settlor or any other person or body for management will stand vested in the Trust and will be subject to control and supervision of the Board.

(b) Board of Trustees:

All trustees collectively will form the Board of Trustees. The affairs of the Trust will be managed by the Board with all the members having equal powers. The Board may delegate its functions to any one or more members with such designation as may be found convenient or necessary subject to control of the Board of Trustees. Death, retirement or insolvency will terminate the membership of the Board as trustee. A trustee can be removed for misconduct after notice to such trustee by a resolution of the Board of Trustees with the consensus of all the other trustees. In the event of demise or retirement of Chair person, successor will be nominated by the outgoing Chairperson and in absence of such nomination; the senior most trustee in age will be the Chair person.

(c) Trustee/ Trustees:

Trustee/Trustees used in this indenture mean in singular any single trustee authorised by the Board of Trustees and trustees in plural would refer the Board collectively.

(d) Meetings of the Board:

Board of Trustees will meet once in three months or as often as required after a week's notice. The meeting will be presided by the Chair-person or senior-most member in her absence. Resolution on urgent matters can be passed by circulation but recorded in the minutes of next meeting. Minutes will be kept for each meeting and signed either by the Chair-person of that or next meeting. Board will be presided by Chair-person or in her absence by the senior-most in age. Decisions will be taken by the majority where there is no consensus. In the event of tie, the Chair-person of the Trust alone will have the casting vote.

7. QUALIFICATION OF THE TRUSTEES

That the first trustees or any other additional trustee that may be appointed hereinafter as per the provisions of this trust deed will cease to be trustees at any time if he suffer from any of the following disqualification:



- a) If he has been found to be of unsound mind by a court of competent jurisdiction.
- b) If he is declared an un-discharged insolvent.
- c) if he has applied to be adjudicated as an insolvent and his application is pending
- d) if he has been convicted by a court of an offence involving moral turpitude
- e) If a trustee conducts himself or acts in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the trust
- f) A member of the trust does not attend four consecutive meetings of the trust without prior permission of the chairman
- g) If he resign from the membership of the trust.

In above mentioned circumstance, the trustee shall be liable to be removed by a resolution of the trust.

8. POWERS OF BOARD/ TRUSTEES

Board shall have all the powers to manage the trust for carrying out the Table objects of the trust. Without affecting the generality of such powers, the Board of Trustees have the following powers and functions:

- 1. The trustee/s consistent with the objects of the Trust may make such arrangements, draw up such schemes and frame such plans, schemes, rules, regulations or bye-laws as necessary for the administration of the trust hereby constituted and may amend, alter or repeal any such rules, regulations or bye-laws as may be considered necessary consistent with the objects of the trust. The Board of Trustees may form committees for any particular purposes and assign such operations and duties to one or more the trustees as may be decided from time to time by resolutions to carry out the rules and regulations so formed.
- 2. The trustee/s shall have powers to invest the corpus funds and its income pending use for the objects of the trust only in investments permitted for public charitable institutions under law governing public trust either of the State, local or Government and more particularly under section 11(5) an 10 (23 C) of the Income tax Act

and analogous provisions of the direct tax laws now or as may be amended from time to time

3. Board of Trustees may open and operate one or more bank accounts including an overdraft account as may be authorised by resolution to be operated by any two of the trustees jointly. The Board will have power to borrow, sign bills of exchange and cheques and authorise for this purpose any two of the Trustees jointly.
4. Board of Trustees shall have power to convert the trust property, acquire immovable property, sell, charge, rent out or otherwise alienate the assets including immovable property for the objects of the Trust.
5. Trustees will have powers to engage, suspend or dismiss employees or to take such other action to ensure proper management. It will have all powers necessary and incidental for management and administration of the Trust and its properties.
6. The Trustees will have the power to borrow if need be against the security of the assets of the trust by way of bank overdraft, loan or otherwise, as may be necessary, for the benefit of the trust and for more effectively carrying out the objects and to bind the trust property for the purposes and enter into any agreement, contract, instrument, document or any other paper or writing required to be signed or executed on behalf of the trustee/s by the two trustees authorised in this behalf to execute such documents, deeds, papers, etc. as may be necessary in connection therewith.
7. To utilise any portion of the corpus or the income of the trust for purchasing any land and or constructing any building or buildings for and in the name of the trust for the purpose of carrying out, promoting and/or executing any or all of the objects of the trust.
8. That in case of any vacancy arising in the board of trustees due to resignation, death, removal or any other reasons, the vacancy shall be filled up by 2/3rd majority of the trustees.
9. The trustees shall frame various rules and regulations for smooth working of the trust and its allied institutions which shall form the part of the trust deed. They shall also get the said deed registered under various laws prevailing in this country.

10. The trustees shall maintain the books of accounts reflecting all its income and expenditure and shall prepare various required statements and balance sheet on 31st March every year.
11. The trustees shall also appoint any professional firm of chartered accountants for the audit of the accounts of the trust and such appointment shall be duly authorized by a resolution and these audited accounts shall be placed before the trustees and shall be binding upon all the trustees.
12. The trustees shall elect chairman of the said trust who shall remain the chairman of the trust till he is removed by 2/3rd majority of the trustees from the chairmanship or he ceases to be one of the trustees of the trust. In case of vacancy of chairmanship another chairman shall be elected by the majority of the trustees in a specially convened meeting for this purpose.
13. The trustees shall have full powers to acquire all things and to do all acts necessary to carry out the objects of the trust.
14. The trustees shall not be entitled to any remuneration for working for the trust but shall be entitled for reimbursement of actual expenses incurred for institution of the trust or for carrying of objects of the trust. They shall also be entitled for travelling expenses for carrying the objects of the trust. The rules and regulations shall be framed by the trustees from time to time.
15. The trustees are hereby indemnified against the consequences of all lawful acts done by the trustees in the course of discharge of their duties as the trustees of the trust.
16. The trust shall be governed by the Board of trustees. The Board of Trustees shall consist of all the trustees. The number of which shall always be not less than 3.
17. The trustees shall be authorized to call any specialist as special invitee to the meeting of the trust.
18. The trustees may elect or nominate one of them as the Managing Trustees and 1st Managing Trustees of this trust shall be Sh. Gaurav Singh Son of Sh. Sampat Singh, Resident of House No.112, Sector 15, Hisar. The Managing Trustee can be removed by 2/3rd Majority of the trustees present in the meeting convened for this specific purpose.

19. The trustees shall also be authorized to receive any voluntary contribution from the trustees or from the public at large and such contributions shall be treated as forming part of the corpus of the trust.
20. Subject to the provisions herein mentioned above the trustees shall not keep with them cash exceeding Rs. 50,000/- at any time.
21. The trustees shall have powers to deposit the trust money or any portion thereof in any nationalized bank or banks either by way of fixed deposit or in a current/ saving account.
22. The trustees shall have powers to invest the trust money in government security or in any other approved fund and shall invest in such a manner as may be decided by the Board of Trustees.
23. The trust money shall not be invested with any private individuals or firms or persons or body of individuals.
24. For the purpose of carrying out the objects of the trust, the trustees shall have the powers to acquire by purchase or on lease or otherwise any immovable property of any tenure and in case of vacant land the trustees shall be at liberty to erect buildings thereon and to do all things necessary to do so and incidental thereto.
25. It shall be lawful for the trustees to renovate, rebuilt, alter, adopt, improve and to develop or repair any immovable property comprised in the trust properties and to expand thereon such moneys, out of the trust fund or the income thereof as they may think fit from time to time.
26. The trustees shall be entitled to enter into any agreements in conveyance with the owners of all persons entitled to or interested in any other properties and to raise funds by way of loans.
27. It shall be lawful for the trustees at such time or times as they may in their absolute discretion think fit to sell by public auction or private contract or exchange or transfer or grant leases or sub leases for any term or otherwise dispose-off all or any part of the trust properties including immovable properties.
28. The trustees may deposit for safe custody any documents held by them relation to any property belonging to the trust under these

presents with any bank and may pay such sum payable in respect of the same.

- 20. The entire control, regulation, management, application and the administration of the trust properties whether capital or otherwise, income rent interests or profits of any kind shall be in the discretion of the trustees.
- 30. Every authority of description consented upon trustees shall be exercised or signified either by some instrument in writing to the signed by all the trustees or such of them as may be present or by the resolution of the trustees.
- 31. The meeting of the board trustees shall be held atleast once in 3 months but any number of other meetings may be held as and when considered necessary.

9. FOR THE OBJECTS (I) TO (XII) AND POWER, RULES AND REGULATIONS TO RAISE OR COLLECT FUNDS, BY SUBSCRIPTIONS, DONATIONS, GIFTS, GRANTS OR ENDOWMENTS.

The Trust is hereby expressly declared to be public charitable Trust and all the provisions of this declaration are to be construed accordingly. If any of its objects in whole or in part on any other provisions of this declaration is found to be repugnant or inconsistent with any of the said provisions are to the relevant date, such objects or provisions shall be deemed to be not in existence to the extent of such repugnancy or inconsistency and if any of the objects of the Trust is found to be invalid on the ground of vagueness or any other reason by competent authority. It shall be deemed to have not been included in the object of the Trust so as to affect the validity of the Trust.

Nothing contained in this declaration shall be deemed to authorize the Founder Trustees to do any act which may in any way be construed as violative or contrary to the provisions of Sections 2(15), 11, 12, 12-A, 35CCA, 35CC, 80-G or any other relevant provision of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modification thereof, and all activities of the Trust shall be carried on with a view to benefit the public at large without any profit motive for charitable purpose only as may be permissible under the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961. The Founder Trustees hereby expressly are authorized to add any other charitable object in the objects

of Trust provided, however, it is charitable object within the meaning of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

10. ACCOUNTS

The trustee/s shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys received and spent in course of management of trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purposes of the trust as well as of all the assets and liabilities of the trust. Accounts shall be closed on 31st March every year and audited by 30th September following by a person qualified as a Chartered Accountant.

11. POWER TO SUE

The trustee/s shall be entitled to sue or to be sued in the name of the trust.

12. DURATION OF THE TRUST:

The trust is irrevocable and will continue in perpetuity.

13. INDEMNITY

Trustee/s shall not be personally liable for any action bone fide undertaken in exercise of their powers and duties as trustee and they shall stand indemnified for any loss or damages to which they may be subject to in such exercise.

14. NO BENEFIT TO SETTLOR, TRUSTEES AND OTHERS

Trustee/s will not be entitled to any benefit, save right to reimbursement of expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties. Neither the settlor, trustees nor their families, nor any member of their families nor any of their relatives or concerns in which any of these persons are interested or any other interested person receive any benefit in violation of section 13 of the Income-tax Act, 1961. Trustees will not engage in any activity unworthy or inconsistent with fiduciary responsibility of the trustees directly or indirectly.

15. SAVING CLAUSE

If any of the foregoing clauses relating to the powers, functions and other matters governing the trust, is likely to be contrary or inconsistent with



any provisions of law relating to public trusts or public charitable institutions entitled to exemptions or concessions under any tax laws more specifically under section 10 (23 C) or section 11 to 13 of the Income-tax Act as now or as may be amended from time to time, such powers will be treated as not forming part of these presents, so as to conform to the requirements of such laws.

16. DISSOLUTION

The trust is irrevocable. But in the event of any circumstances in which it is decided to determine the trust, the trust property after meeting all liabilities shall be given or transferred to some other institution engaged in similar objects and functioning without profit motive and eligible for exemption under section 10 (23 C) or 11 of the Income-tax Act as public charitable institution. The Assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees.

The settlor and the other three trustees in token of having accepted to act as trustees and having taken over the corpus affix their respective signatures hereto as Chair-person and Members of Board of Trustees.
